#### **Costumes and harness**

Any official equestrian style is permitted! Consistency between costume and harness, as well as the care taken in presenting the pairing, will be particularly appreciated. All categories must wear a riding helmet in accordance with current regulations. For the dressage event, other specific headgear is authorised (e.g. top hat). See the ARSETS directive 'Bridles and Bits' and the ARSETS rules for dress and tack. Compliance with these rules must be observed throughout the event area.

Until 17 June 2024 (payment included); after that date, there will be an additional fee of CHF 40.00 for late registration. The number of participants is limited to 50. Entries will be accepted in the order in which payment is received. A waiting list will be set up if necessary.
